
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed black pine post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which: 12" red fir bears N72 40'W-6.0'. In 8" black pine bears S60 E-0.6'. Both marked B.T.A.3-477.



## Description of corner evidence found:

ad Three Star Corner 2. The corner area has been obliterated by road building.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

et a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and urrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

7" white fir bears S30½°E-31.1' scribed 3-A-477 BT.
6" lodgepole pine bears S72½°E-50.9' scribed 3-A-477 BT.
6" bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze.
6 tached sign 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and
6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National
6 to both posts.

sed steel tape and staff compass with  $20^{\circ}$ E celination, measured to the center of the sering trees.

is corner was remonumented on August 30, 1985.
