
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

the corner was originally established by Arthur Philbric under Mineral Survey No. 477, during the survey of June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed slate stone, 24" by 18" by 12", was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

A 20" red fir bears N870401-8.831. A 14" red fir bears N15018'W-29.59'. Both marked B.T.B.Mt.3-S.3-477.

Description of corner evidence found:

wound a 24" by 18" by 12" slate stone with chisel marks and an "X" on the top om which:

30" white fir stump bears N16 $\frac{1}{2}$ W-30.4' with catface (original bearing tree). The rotted remains of a white fir bear N88 $^{\circ}$ W-9' $^{\pm}$ with fragmentary scribing sible (original bearing tree).

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

t a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and grounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried stone monument in the From the new monument: cund beside the new monument.

7" engleman spruce bears N66½°W-17.4' scribed 3-BM-3-S-477 BT.
6" white fir bears N65½°E-5.1' scribed 3-BM-3-S-477 BT.
10 new bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts National Forest Boundary NW and SE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one t and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Read steel tape and staff compass with 20°E clination, measured to the center of the tearing trees.

his corner was remonumented on August 14, 1985.
