
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during the survey of June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed tamarack post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

A 6" black pine bears S41°15'E-22.2'. A 6" black pine bears N32°40'W-25.62'. Both marked B.T.C.4-477.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found the rotted remains of the original post at ground level in a mound of earth and stone from which:

A dead and down, very rotten lodgepole pine bears $841\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}E-23^{\frac{1}{2}}$ with not scribing visible (original bearing tree). This tree is too rotten to attach signs. An 8" dead, down lodgepole pine bears N32 $3/4^{\circ}W-26^{\frac{1}{2}}$ with visible scribing (original bearing tree).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

A 9" engleman spruce bears $$36\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$W-13.4'$ scribed 4-C-477 BT.$ An 8" alpine fir bears $$79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$E-7.5'$ scribed 4-C-477 BT.$ New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Fores Boundary NE and SE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on August 14, 1985.
