
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by William Elmer under Mineral Survey No. 599 during August and September 1905. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed tamarack post 4' long by 6" sq. was set 2' in the ground and surrounded by a mound of earth from which:

A 6" pine bears N51°45'E-8.50'. A 42"Abears N21: 55'E-7'. Both marked 2-599 D.D. B.T.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a mound of earth and stone with the rotted remains of the post in a hole in the middle and the remains of the original post lying beside the mound. From the mound:

A 9" dead lodgepole pine bears N22°E-7.3' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree).
A 10" dead lodgepole pine bears N51 3/4°E-8.8' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone and placed the remains of the original post on the mound. From the monument:

An 8" western larch bears S62½ E-30.3' scribed 2-DD-599 BT.

A 9" western larch bears S10½ W-16.2' scribed 2-DD-599 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze.

Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National

Forest Boundary SW and NW of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on August 30, 1985.
