
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Corner No.2, Annululu Lode, M.S. 382 A

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner ORIGINALLY established by C.M.Foster, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor under instructions dated December 7, 1899, for mineral survey no. 382A & B.

Surveyor General records state: A pine post 4' long 4" square set 18" in ground scribed 2-382-A. Old location SW corner S51°45'W, 75' dist whence: A fir 8" dia brs N46°20'W, 44.3' dist blazed and scribed 2-382-A BT. A fir 30" dia brs N5°45'W, 26.7' dist blazed and scribed 2-382-A BT.



Corner RECOVERED and PERPETUATED by J.R.Mitchell, experienced corner recovery technician, as noted below. No record filed with Baker County Surveyor.

## Description of corner evidence found:

A 2½" brass cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe in rock mound (as shown beside) with 4" x 4" x 30" wood post scribed COR 3 BHE one face and MS on other.

JRM-BT: A lodgepole pine 7" dia brs N22 W, 34.0' dist mkd AN2 MS 382ABT on partially healed blaze.

OBT: A 24" white fir brs N46 20'W, 44.3' dist per record.

A rotten fir stub 8' high with pitched over blaze alongside scribed OR NO2 ANNULULU MS 382 BT brs N05 45'W, 26.7' dist per record.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of JRM brass cap monument which is the best remaining evidence of original bearing tree...

Removed JRM brass cap, destroyed rock mound and set post alongside. Set 2 " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground surrounded with rock mound. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Set steel fence post with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

Each BT has signs 54-3 & 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and painted blaze. Compass declination  $20^{\circ}$  East.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly remonumented to U.S.F.S. standards by me and witnessed by Bill Gohring on October 14,1987.
