

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner ORIGINALLY established by C.M.Foster U.S. Deputy Surveyor under instructions for MS 447 and dated September 25, 1901.

Surveyor General records state: A pine post  $4\frac{1}{2}$  long 4" square set 18" in ground surrounded with mound of earth scribed Boulder-2-447 from which: The SW cor of amended location bears S 60°20'W, 280' dist...

A fir 8" dia brs N18°30'E, 17' dist blazed & scribed Boulder 2-477-BT. A tamarack 10" dia brs S51°30'E, 26.4' dist blazed &

scribed Goulder 2-447-BT.

Corner RECOVERED and PERPETUATED by J.R.Mitchell, experienced corner recovery technician, as noted below. No record filed with Baker County Surveyor.

## Description of corner evidence found:

A  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe in rock mound with rotten remains of wood post alongside, cap marked as shown to right, from whigh:
JRM BT: A western larch 6" dia brs N83 W, 23.4' dist mkd BL2 MS 447 BT on partially healed blaze.

OBT: A western larch 14" dia brs S51 $\frac{1}{2}$  E, 26.4' dist per record with partially healed blaze.

A rotten fir root brs  $N18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ , 17.0' dist per record.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of JRM brass cap monument which is the best remaining evidence of original corner...

Removed brass cap monument and replaced with 2 " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground surrounded with rock mound. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Set steel fence post with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

No new bearing trees established. Each bearing tree has a sign 54-3 & 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint and a painted blaze. Compass declination 20° East.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly remonumented to U.S.F.S. standards by me and witnessed by Bill Gohring on October 14, 1987.
