CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


Cor.No.2, Chapman Lode MS382A, identical with Cor.No.3, Rainbow Lode MS447.

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was ESTABLISHED in 1899 by C.M.Foster, U.S.deputy mineral surveyor as follows: To Cor No.2. A fir post 4 ft long 4 ins square, set 18 ins in the ground, scribed 2-382, whence, A fir 16 ins dia bears N8^OW, 21 ft dist blazed and scribed 2-382, A, B.T. A fir 12 ins dia bears N44^O30 W, 58 ft dist blazed and scribed 2-382, A B.T.

RECOVERED & AMENDED in 1901 by the same C.M.Foster, as follows To Cor.No.3. A pine post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft long 4 ins square, set 18 ins in the ground, surrounded with a mound of earth scribed

Rainbow - Cor.3-447 and Chapman - Cor.2-382. Identical with angular cor. post of amended location and with cor. post No.2 of the Chapman Lode Mkd. 382.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by survey (see Record of Survey Plat filed separately for method of corner position reestablishment)...

Set 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia aluminum cap attached 25" in ground surrounded with a mound of earth & stone and placed 6' steel fence post alongside with signs 54-9 attached. Aluminum cap marked as shown to the right...

New bearing trees established: A lodgepole pine 10" diam brs S19½°W, 24.3' dist mkd C-2-382A-R-3-447 BT. A lodgepole pine 10" diam brs S80°E, 41.4' dist mkd C-2-382A-R-3-447 BT.

Each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 & 54-9 attached below a surrounding 6" band of red paint and has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to red painted blaze.

Compass declination 20° East.
