Description of corner evidence found:

B. MONUMENT FOUND:

I found a 4"x3"x7" pointed rotted remains of wood post 12" in the ground

ACCESSORIES FOUND:

Dead and down Ponderosa Pine with blaze and visible scribe of "S B". Root hole centerline bears N72E, 3.0 ft. Ponderosa Pine sawn stump bears SBE, 20.6 ft. with no visible marks.
