Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

CORNER WORK DONE ON 6/14/90

At the locus of distance-distance (bearings weak) from the bearing trees Ċ. I set a 2.5" dia. by 30" long aluminum pipe with a 2.5" dia. aluminum cap. The pipe is set in the toe of jeep road fill. Mounded stones to 2" of the top and placed large slab rock on fill to protect monument. MS 485 Cap is marked

Painted the blaze red on each BT

Placed 6 ft. metal guard post at corner with metal PROPERTY BOUNDARY sign

and metal ATTENTION sign (54-2 and 54-4)
