At the intersect of the bearing tree distances I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 32" Aluminum capped Aluminum pipe 24" in the ground in a mound of earth from which

A 6" White Fir bears N 22° 30' W 37.23ft. marked \square S22 BT nail in S base.
A 7" White Fir bears S 54° W 18.59ft. marked \square S27 BT nail in W base.

Bearings taken with a staff compass declination  $18\frac{1}{2}$  East per 1980 Isogonic chart.

Distances pulled to 60d nail with Brass washer stamped LS 1898 driven in the side center of the bearing trees.
