
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established by Eugene P. McCornack under GLO contract no. 398 dated July 2, 1881.

Surveyor General records state:

Set post 4 ft long 4 ins square 24 inches in the ground for cor to sees 7, 12, 13 and 18 marked T 9 S S 7 on NE, R 37 E S 18 on SE, R 36 E S 13 onn SW, and S 12 on NW faces with 2 notches on N and 4 notches on S edges from which:



A fir 10 ins diam bears N 15° E, 20 lks dist marked T 9 S R 37 E S 7 BT A fir 14 ins diam bears S 5° E, 28 lks dist marked T 9 S R 37 E S 18 BT A pine 40 ins diam bears S 30° W, 25 lks dist marked T 9 S R 36 E S 13 BT A fir 6 ins diam bears N 30° W, 15 lks dist marked T 9 S R 36 E S 12 BT

Description of corner evidence found:

The southwest BT is a fir 38 ins diam with healed blace. The southwest BT is a fir 38 ins diam with full scribes fisible. The northwest BT is a down rotten tree with fragmentary scribes. The northwest BT is a dead fir 26 ins diam and healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established as locus of distance intersections from the above described accessories set a 2½ inch aluminum dap on a 2 inch aluminum pipe 31 inches long and projecting 6 inches out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound. Placed a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked thus:

T 9 S R 36 E R 37 E S 12 S 23 1984 ORLS 1639

New bearing trees: A fir 7 ins diam bears N 16° E, 67.0 ft dist marked X BT A fir 10 ins diam bears N 26° W, 137.4 ft dist marked T 9 S R 36 E S 12 BT

Each of these bearing trees has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and all accessories have a sign 54-3 and sign 54-9 attached below a red band of paint around.
