
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed tamarack post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground from which:

A 16" tamarack bears N40°55'W-20.89'. A 6" red fir bears S84°35'E-37.02'. Both marked B.T.B.Mt. 1-477.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found remains of the original post lying on the original earth mound. Also, found remains of the post underground from which:

A 23" western larch bears N41 W-21.5! with healed blaze (original bearing tree).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed remains of original post on the mound. From the monument:

A 6" white fir bears N48°E-7.3' scribed 1-BM-477 BT. New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted the face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary SE and SW of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on July 24, 1985.
