## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July of 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed tamarack post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which:


A 30" red fir bears N26°12'E-44.35'.

A 14" black pine bears S1 10'W-85.90'.

Both marked B.T.F. 2-477.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 43" white fir bears N26½ E-44.4' to face blaze and 45.3' scribing visible on open blaze (original bearing tree).



Description of corner evidence found: A 43" white fir bears N26½ E-44.4' to face blaze and 45.3' to center line with scribing visible on open blaze (original bearing tree). An 18" lodgepole pine stump bears  $S1\frac{1}{4}$  W-85.9' to face blaze and 86.5' to center line with scribing visible on butt of tree lying beside stump.

Re-established corner by record bearing and distance from the remaining bearing trees. Measured to face of blaze for corner re-establishment.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stone. from which:

An 8" douglas fir bears N1½°W-18.0' scribed 2-F-477 BT.

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze.

Attached signs 54-9 and 54-3 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National forest Boundary NE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on July 24, 1985.
