
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

This corner was not "originally established".

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

A 12" engleman spruce bears  $S89^{\circ}E-41.2$ ' scribed Intex-BM-C-477 BT. A 13" engleman spruce bears  $S40^{\circ}E-35.9$ ' scribed Intex-BM-C-477 BT. New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary SE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with  $20^{\circ}\mathrm{E}$  declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on August 30, 1985.
