
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

West End Center Corner, Annululu Lode, M.S. 382 A

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner ORIGINALLY established by C.M. Foster, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor under instructions dated December 7, 1899, for mineral survey no. 382A & B.

Surveyor General records state: A pine post 4' long 4" square set 18" in ground scribed W Cen end-382-A identical with W Cen end of original location. A fir 8" dia brs S33°E, 20' dist blazed and scribed W Cen end-382-A BT.

Corner RECOVERED and PERPETUATED by J.R.Mitchell, experienced corner recovery technician, as noted below. No record filed with Baker County Surveyor.

## Description of corner evidence found:

No trace of original pine post.

A  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe in rock mound (as shown beside) with 4" x 4" x 24" wood post alongside with fragment scribes, from which: JRM BT: A white fir 6" dia brs N58°E, 17.4' mkd "AN

WEC MS 447 BT on partially healed blaze.

A white fir 6" dia brs S76°E 10.5' mkg "AN WEC MS 447 BT".

OBT: A sawed fir stump 18" dia brs S33°E, 20' dist per record with lower portion of blaze visible inside 5" overgrowth & 4" from center of tree no visible scribes.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of JRM brass cap monument which is the best remaining evidence of original corner...

Removed brass cap monument and replaced with 2 " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground surrounded with rock mound. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Set steel fence post with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

Removed the marks from JRM BTs and marked the following new BTs: A lodgepole pine 8" dia brs  $S22^{\circ}W$ , 70.5' dist mkd A-WEC-382A BT. A western larch 9" dia brs  $S60^{\circ}W$ , 73.8' dist mkd A-WEC-382A BT.

Each BT has a sign 54-3 & 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 20° East.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly remonumented to U.S.F.S. standards by me and witnessed by Bill Gohring on October 14, 1987.
