Set 2 " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground with 5" projecting out of ground surrounded with rock mound. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Set steel fence post alongside with signs 54-9 attached.

New bearing trees established: A western larch 11 ins dia. brs. $804\frac{1}{2}^{O}W$, 21.4 ft dist marked R-2-B-5-447BT. A lodgepole pine 7 ins dia. brs. $842^{O}E$, 31.0 ft dist marked R-2-B-5-447BT.

Each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to BT blaze and has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a red band of paint. The BT blaze is also painted red. Compass declination is 20° East.
