
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Cor.No.4, Rainbow Lode, MS 447.

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was ESTABLISHED in 1901 by C.M.Foster, U.S. deputy mineral surveyor, as follows:

To cor. No.4 On line 2-3 of Chapman Lode MS 382, A pine post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft long, 6 ins square, set 18 ins in the ground, surrounded with a mound of earth, scribed Rainbow 4-447.



Description of corner evidence found:

A 10" diam lodgepole pine snag mkd RAINBOW-4-447 BT on partially healed blaze inside $\frac{1}{2}$ " overgrowth brs S86°E, 6.2' dist for corner point (blaze faces S50°W). There is no record of this BT in original mineral survey notes and it is therefore rejected.

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by survey (see Record of Survey Plat filed separately for method of corner position reestablishment)...

Set 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia aluminum cap attached 25" in ground surrounded with a mound of earth & stone and placed 6' steel fence post alongside with signs 54-9 & 54-2 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown to the right...

New bearing trees established: A lodgepole pine 9" diam brs N47 $^{\circ}$ E, 69.9' dist mkd R-4-447 BT. A lodgepole pine 10" diam brs N77 $^{\circ}$ E, 79.5' dist mkd R-4-447 BT.

Each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 & 54-9 attached below a surrounding 6" band of red paint and has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush to red painted blaze.

Compass declination 20° East.
