Set a fir post 4 ins. square, 4.5 ft. long, 18 ins. in the ground, with a mound of earth around it, marked it MYRTLE COR 3 375 for Cor. No. 3. A white pine tree 6 ins. in bears N56W, 20.0 ft. A white fir tree 15 ins. in diam. bears S41E, 20.0 ft. both blazed and The SW cor. of location bears N84W, 212.0 ft marked MYRTLE COR 3 375 BT.

At the position of the pointed post remnant, set a 2.5° dia. by 30° long aluminum pipe with a 2.5° dia. aluminum cap. The pipe is set 18° in the ground with mound of earth and stone to 4° of the top. C_{\bullet} The cap is marked
