History of original corner establishment:

John Hagel, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under Mineral Survey No. 375, surveyed the Fred Knuthetal claim known as Myrtle Quartz Claim September 24,25, 1899 and approved by the U.S. Surveyor General s Office.

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SURVEYOR GENERAL'S RECORD STATES:

Set a fir post 4 ins. square, 4.5 ft. long, 18 ins. in the ground, with a mound of stones and earth around marked it MYRTLE COR 4 375 for Cor. No. 4. A red fir tree 11 ins. in diam. bears S87-30W, 49.2 ft., and a white fir tree 9 ins. in diam. bears S24-30E, 68.2 ft., both blazed and marked MYRILE COR 4 375 BT

Description of corner evidence found:

B. MONUMENT FOUND:

Found 3"x4"x25" remains of wood post on hillside with scribing of "COR 4 MS 375" but could not locate any evidence of post below surface.

ACCESSORIES FOUND:

27" dia. Grand Fir with healed blaze bears S89W, 49.2 ft. (note: this bearing tree was tied into my traverse and the monument was set using solar traverse reverse bearing—the bearing shown is from my compass after monument was set.)

CORNER WORK DONE ON 6/7/90

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the locus of distance and reversed bearing from the original bearing tree, set a 2.5° dia. by 30° long aluminum pipe with a 2.5° dia. aluminum C. The pipe is set 18" in the ground on bedrock with large mound of earth and stone to 4" of the top. The cap is marked
