History of original corner establishment:

A. John Hagel, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under Mineral Survey No. 375, surveyed the Fred Knuthetal claim known as Myrtle Quartz Claim September 24,25, 1899 and approved by the U.S. Surveyor General's Office.

SURVEYOR GENERAL'S RECORD STATES:

Identical with the NW cor. of location. A living yellow pine tree 18 in diam., marked it MYRTLE COR NO 5 375. A yellow pine tree 20 ins. in diam. bears 567-15E, 8.5 ft. A tamarack tree 9 ins. in diam. bears N42-50E, 28.0 ft. Both blazed and marked MYRTLE COR 5 375 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

B. MONUMENT FOUND:

Found the root collar and roots of the original corner tree.

ACCESSORIES FOUND:

16" dia. Western Larch snag with healed blaze bears N46E, 27.0 ft. 28" dia. Ponderosa Pine sawn stump bears S67E, 8.6 ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

C. At the locus of root collar and root remains of the original corner tree set a 2.5" dia. by 30" long aluminum pipe with a 2.5" dia. aluminum cap. The pipe is set 24" in the ground with large mound of stone and earth to the top.

Placed 6 ft. metal guard post at corner with metal PROPERTY BOUNDARY signand metal ATTENTION sign (54-2 and 54-4)

I measured to the centerline of each bearing tree using tape and hand compass with declination set at 20 degrees east.
