A pine post 4 ins. square at the top, 4 ft. long, set 1.5 ft. in the ground with a mound of earth and stone, scribed 3-813-PACIFIC, whence A tamarack 8 ins. dia. bears \$25-30E., 27 ft., and A tamarack 8 ins. dia. bears \$100 \text{N81-30W.}, 19.1 ft. each blazed and scribed 3 813 PACIFIC BT

## B. MONUMENT FOUND:

I found the rotted remains of wood post on surface with axe marks visible and found pointed decaying end remains 4"x4"x12" post 14" in the ground.

## ACCESSORIES FOUND:

11" dia. Western Larch (dead) leaning/windthrown with blaze and scribing visible of "813 PAC BT" bears S25-30E 27 ft.
Root collar and hole of tamarack bears N81-30W at 19 ft.
