History of original corner establishment: Corner was originally established in 1978 by William L. Hanley under Baker County Survey Number 9-37-20. His record does not state what was set.

In 1981, William L. Hanley re-established this corner's position. His record on the Certified Record of Land Corner Monumentation form, Baker County Survey Number 9-37-63, states:

1981 ORLS 1639

Corner established by William L. Hanley, ORLS 1639, in the course of survey of Golden Chariot Estates subdivision. Found a 1% inch iron pipe projecting 2% feet out of the ground at a point which bears N5°W, 11.6 feet from proper corner location. Set a 2% inch brass cap on a 1 inch iron pipe 31 inches long and projecting 5 inches out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound. Brass cap marked thus: (SEE DIAGRAM).

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2% ins. brass cap on a 1 inch iron pipe projecting 5 inches out of the ground in a mound of stone, marked as shown in DIAGRAM.

No accessories were established.

Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe as taken this survey. Nailed Bearing Tree (54-3) signs above blaze and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs on back of each tree as required. Painted a 6" red band above Bearing Trees signs. Measurements to BT's taken with a magnetic compass, declination 20° East, and a nylon clad steel tape. Set steel fence post with Land Survey Monument (54-9) and Property Boundary (54-2) signs 5' south and 4' east of the monument.
