

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Corner falls at North edge of 6" White Fir. Cut tree down. Set pipe 24" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

ft. scribed CS1/16S19 BT. An 8" pine bears S02°W, 16.8 ft. scribed CS1/16S19
BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and Brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' North and 54-2 and 54-9 on steel fence post 5' West of the corner.
