
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. Z-7

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by E. McCormack under G.L.O. contract No. 39B, September 27,1881.

Surveyor General's notes state: "Set a basalt stone 14 X 12 X 9 ins. in the ground for 1/4 section corner marked 1/4 on North face and raised a mound of stone alongside."

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of corner stone. Found 4" X 4" X 30" rotten wood post set in ground with mound of stone around. Old glass insulator broken under mound. Two recently defaced BTs found to the NE and SW. STS notes show 3 1/2" X 3 1/2" X 36" wood posts used to mark corners. No other signs of a corner in the area.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of the above post, set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 18" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 7" fir bears N08°W, 30.0 ft. scribed 1/4S32 BT. A 9"

fir bears S62°W, 83.1 ft scribed 1/4S5 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washers

stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5° West and 54-2 on a steel fence post 5° South of the corner.
