

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION



Original survey of mineral survey by William Hanley O.R.L.S. 1639 under contract No. 53 04HI-8-7079N for the U.S. Forest Service dated May 1979.

Angle point No. 1 is a 5/8" X 30" rebar set 24" in the ground. No accessories set.



Description of corner evidence found:

At the Angle point location I found the rebar as set by William Hanley.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I replaced William Hanley's rebar with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X32" brass capped steel pipe set 24" in the ground from which:


An 8" Lodgepole Pine bears S6 45 E 34.10ft. marked A P S30 BT Nail in E. base.

An 8" Lodgepole Pine bears S82°30'W 32.52ft. marked X BT Nail in N. base.

Monument stamped:

Bearings taken with a staff compass declination $18\frac{1}{2}^{\bullet}\,\text{East}$ per 1980 Isogonic chart.

Distances pulled to 60d nails with brass washers marked LS 1898 set in the side center of bearing trees.
