No trace of original pine post.

A large rotten pine stump with full scribes on fragments brs S40E, 29.8 ft. A windblow pine 20 ins dia with full scribes on log 50' downhill.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30 ins long 25 ins in ground with 5 ins proj. out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6 ft steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

A fir 7 ins dia bears N74 $^{\circ}$ 15'W 38.6 ft marked K-1-679 BT. A fir 17 ins dis bears S12 $^{\circ}$ 30'E 89.7 ft marked K-1-679 BT.

Each original bearing tree and each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 in band of red paint, additionally each new bearing tree has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
