
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30 ins long 25 ins in ground with 5 ins proj. out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6 ft steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A fir 10 ins dia bears N23 $^{10}_{2}$ W 17.6 ft marked A-AGF-679 BT. A fir 11 ins dia bears S78 0 W 11.2 ft marked A-AGF-679 BT.

Each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 in band of red paint and brass washers marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
