Set a post 4½ ft long 4 ins square set 12 ins in ground with mound of stone mark ed Cor No 5 LCPC MS 257. A tamarack 8 ins dia bears N75 W 0.24 chs blazed and marked Cor No 5 LCPC MS 257 BT, a tamarack 30 ins dia bears N27030'E 0.36 chs blazed and marked Cor No 5 LCPC MS 257 BT.

Corner established by John Hagel, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under instruc-

tions received from United States General for Oregon, dated April 7, 1902, and designated as Survey No 470. Surveyor General records state: Found a pine post 5 ins square 3 ft above ground scribed LCPCC 5 S 257 with mound of rocks around it. Set a black pine post 4 ins square 4½ ft long 18 ins in ground alongside old post scribed GRB 4-470, DPL 1-470. A black pine 8 ins dia bears S20 30 W 23.3 ft marked GRB 4-470 BT.

Corner position remonumented by John R. Mitchell in 1980...Set a 2½ ins brass cap on a 32"x 1" galv pipe in rock mound marked LCPCC 5 MS 257. A douglas fir 10 ins dia bears  $N10^{\circ}W$  16 ft marked LCPCC 5 MS 257 BT.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found monument set by John R. Mitchell.

A tamarack 16 ins dia bears N75°W 24 lks with healed blaze. A lodgepole pine 10 ins dia bears S34°W 14.9 ft with scribes DPCC 1-470 BT. A ponderosa pine 17 ins dia bears S20°30'W 23.3 ft with healed blaze. A stump 30 ins dia bears N27°30'E 37 lks with no scribes visible.

Tree found set by John R. Mitchell:

A tamarack 7 ins dia bears S10 E 16 ft with scribes LCPC 5 MS 257 BT.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30 ins long 25 ins in ground with 5 ins proj. out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6 ft steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Buried monument alongside.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

Each original bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.
