
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30 ins long 25 ins in ground with 5 ins proj. out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6 ft steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A fir 6 ins dia bears S35 $^{10}_{2}$ W 46.0 ft dist. A fir 7 ins dia bears N47 $^{0}$ E 34.6 ft dist, both trees marked 1 2 HPC 410/S 32 BT.

Each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint and has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
