
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30 ins long 25 ins in ground with 5 ins proj. out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6 ft steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

A pine 8 ins dia bears  $S16^{10}_{2}$ W 64.3 ft dist . A fir 8 ins dia bears  $S42^{0}$ W 49.3 ft dist, both trees marked 9-1-HPC 410/S-6-BRB 470 BT.

Each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint and has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
