
Description of corner evidence found:

No trace of original pine post.

Found a 2 " dia brass cap attached to a 1" dia galvanized iron pipe in rock mound from which: (brass cap mkd as shown to right)

OBT: A sawed lodgepole pine stump 14" dia brs S58^O30'W, 12.5' per record with small piece of lower blaze inside 3" overgrowth and 5' long butt alongside mkd ANNULULU MILLSITE MS 382 COR 3 BT. No trace of other OBT.

JRM-BT: A lodgepole pine 10" dia brs N69°W, 19.9' dist mkd 3-382B BT. A lodgepole pine 8" dia brs N24°W, 32.5' dist mkd 3-382B BT. Both JRM-BT's have a partially healed blaze.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of JRM brass cap monument which is the best available evidence of original corner position...

Removed brass cap monument & replaced with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in ground surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Set 6' steel fence post alongside with signs 54-2 & 54-9. Painted 6" band of red paint around each OBE & JRM-BT, also painted blaze red and attached signs 54-3 & 54-9. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Compass declination 20° East.
