
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Corner No.6, Rainbow Lode, M.S. 447

History of original corner establishment:

Corner ESTABLISHED by C.M.Foster, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor under instructions dated September 25, 1901, for mineral survey no 447.

Surveyor General records state: A tamarack post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft long 5 ins square set 18 ins in ground surrounded with a mound of earth scribed Rainbow Cor 6-447. Identical with the SE cor post of ammended location from which: A tamarack 16 ins in diam bears S82 50 W, 60 ft dist blazed & scribed Rainbow 6-447-BT.



Corner RECOVERED and PERPETUATED by J.R.Mitchell, experienced corner recovery technician, as noted below. No record filed with Baker County Surveyor.

Description of corner evidence found:

A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe in rock mound (as shown beside) with 4"x4"x30" wood post alongside with fragmentary scribes, from which: OBT:A 16" western larch snag stub 20' nigh with partially healed blaze scribed Rainbow Cor 6-447 BT brs S87 W(record,S82°50'W), 60.0' dist per record. JRM BT: A white fir with bug ravaged top 11" dia brs N39°W, 14.0' dist marked RBW 6-MS447 BT. JRM BT: A dead white fir 7" dia brs N15 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E, 7.3' mkd RBW 6-MS447 BT on partially healed blaze.



Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of JRM brass cap monument which is the best remaining evidence of original corner...

Removed brass cap monument and replaced with 2 " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground surrounded with rock mound. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Set steel fence post with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

New bearing trees established: A western larch 15" dia brs $S09^{\circ}E$, 33.6' dist mkd R-6-447 BT. A western larch 14" dia brs $S50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$, 69.9' dist mkd R-6-447 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red paint around each BT.

Compass declination 20° East.
