
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner ESTABLISHED by John Hagel U.S.Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under instructions dated October 19, 1899, for the survey of the Century Lode, a portion of MS 378. Surveyor General records state: To Cor No 4 (of the Century Lode). Set a white fir post 4 ins square  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft long 18 ins in ground with a mound of rocks around it, marked Century C.4-378. A white fir tree 10 ins diam bears N61 15'E, 64.0 ft. A white fir tree 8 ins diam bears S63 E, 30.5 ft. Both blazed and marked Century C.4-378 BT.



Corner RECOVERED & AMMENDED by Wm.W.Elmer, U.S.Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under instructions dated November 28, 1905, for the survey of the Orleans Quartz Mining Claim, MS 653 A. Surveyor General records state: Cor No 2 (of the Orleans Lode), identical with Cor No 4, Sur No 378, Century Lode, a post 5 ins square set in ground with mound of earth & stone scribed Centy.C-4-378, 2-653A Or., whence a fir 16 ins dia bears N85 22'W, 7.85 ft. A pine 6 ins dia bears S38 42'E, 40.20 ft, both blazed and scribed 2-653 A.,OR. BT.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Corner RECOVERED & PERPETUATED by J.R.Mitchell, experience corner recovery technician, as noted below. No record fill with Baker County Surveyor.

Found a JRM  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on 1" galvanized iron pipe with surrounding rock mound and rotting pieces of wood with fragmentary scribe marks, brass cap marked as shown to right, from which: OBT: A white fir 22" dia with fully healed blaze brs  $N63\frac{1}{2}$ E, 43.4' dist(record,  $N61^{\circ}15^{\circ}E$ , 64.0' dist).

A white fir 20" dia with fully healed blaze brs  $S60\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ (record,  $S63^{\circ}E$ ), 30.5' dist per record. A white fir 29" dia with fully healed blaze brs  $N85^{\circ}22^{\circ}W$ , 7.85' dist per record. No trace of other MS 653 A BT.

JRM BT: A white fir 11" dia with partially healed blaze brs  $N10\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ , 37.0' dist mkd CEN 4 MS 378 BT.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of JRM brass cap monument... Removed brass cap monument & replaced with a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground, surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Set 6' steel fence post alongside with sigh 54-9 & 54-2 attached.

No new bearing trees established.

Painted 6" band of red paint around each OBT & JRM BT, also painted blaze  $_{\rm 1}$  attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 to all BTs.

Compass declination 20° East.
