
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner ESTABLISHED by Wm.W.Elmer, U.S.Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under instructions dated November 28, 1905, for the survey of the Orleans Quartz Mining Claim, MS 653 A. Surveyor General records state: Cor No 4 (Orleans Lode), a pine post 4 ins square, 4 ft long set $l^{\frac{1}{2}}$ ft in ground with mound of earth and stone, scribed 4-653 A. Or., whence a pine 6 ins dia bears \$42^15'W, 15.65 ft, a pine 8 ins dia bears \$22^226'E, 20.10 ft, both blazed and scribed 4-653 A Or. BT. Cor No 1 Orleans Mill Site bears \$47^33'W, 5 ft.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" long steel pipe projecting 3" above the ground in surrounding rock mound, origin unknown, from which:

OBT: A lodgepole pine 13" dia with partially healed blaze mkd 1-653B ORMBT & 4 653A ORBT brs S22 26'E, 20.10' dist per record.

A lodgepole pine 9" dia with partially healed blaze mkd A OR BT & 653 B OR M BT brs S42 15'W, 15.65' dist per record. Additionally, a lodgepole pine 20" dia with previously opened blaze with face axed over and fragmentary scribe marks remaining brs S65 E, 12.2'(no record of this tree).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of $1\frac{1}{2}$ " dia steel pipe...

Removed $1\frac{1}{2}$ " dia steel pipe & replaced with a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground, surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Set 6' steel fence post alogside with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached. Buried original pipe inside aluminum pipe.

No new bearing trees established.

Painted 6" band of red paint around each original BT, also painted blaze r attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 to all BTs.

Compass declination 20° East.
