The Southernmost point on the base line is N. 81° 44′ W., 19 feet from the Southwest corner of Lot 6, Block 4 of said addition. Mill Street plat bearing is N. 8° 16′ E., and intersecting streets bear S. 81° 44′ E.

Mr. Schmitz located a point between his building and that of his neighbor's building for future use in establishing a boundary line agreement for the two properties. The point was monumented as part of this

Valley Railroad Station Grounds and right of way is as approximate, due to uncertainty of original location.
