NARRATIVE

This survey for J.K.S. Architecture is for purpose of marking on the ground the corners of Lots 11 and 12, Block 3 of Ellis Addition in Sumpter, Oregon preparatory for their design of new post office building. The Woodwell baseline, 19 feet West of East line of Mill Street, is basis of bearings. The South Woodwell nail monument, N.81°44'W., 19.0 feet from the Southwest corner of Block 4 was recovered and this subject parcel was laid out by direct measurements from that control.
