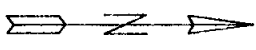

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO LOCATE AND MONUMENT THE OUTSIDE BOUNDARY OF TAX LOT #900 & VACATED NORTH STREET. THE SURVEY CONTROL USED WAS THE WOODWELL BASELINE AND CS #9-37-227-1. THE TWO MONUMENTS SET ALONG SUMPTER VALLEY HWY. ARE APPROXIMATE ONLY. THE BASE BEARING OF THIS SURVEY IS THE EAST LINE OF LOT 9 BLOCK 1 AS SHOWN ON MAP.
