
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

William E. Campbell, U.S. Deputy Surveyor September 22, 1896

42.06 A tamarack, 15 ins. diam., on line, I mark with notches on N. and S. sides; decend; hill bears N.20°W., and S.20°E., through dence undergroth.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 12" diam. dead tree, 15-20' tall, visible notches on the north side, did not see any on south side as in the notes, the tree has fire damage.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

A tamarack 7" in diam., bears S.19°30'W., 55.7', double blazed and scribed "LT BT" with nail and washer "RLS 1060".

A fir, 10" in diam., bears N.51°W., 35', double blazed and scribed "X BT" with nail and washer "RLS 1060"

Placed Forest Service signs (54-2,54-9) on trees and paint scars, blazes and a 6" red band around BT's.
