NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO CREATE A SMALL TRACT TO BE CONVEYED FROM NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS (ADMINISTERED BY THE WALLOWA-WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST) TO ROD & ANN SCHNEIDER. THIS TRACT COVERS AN AREA ENCROACHED UPON BY A SEPTIC SYSTEM, WHICH WAS LOCATED BY RELYING ON OLD FOREST SERVICE PROPERTY BOUNDARY SIGNS. THESE SIGNS WERE PLACED WITHOUT THE BENEFIT OF A LAND

THIS SURVEY UTILIZED THE SE 1/16 AND THE CE 1/16, SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, W.M., FOR CONTROL. THESE MONUMENTS WERE ESTABLISHED BY DOUGLAS FERGUSON, L.S. NO. 848, IN COUNTY SURVEY NO. 9-37-181, FILED 1-22-92. THIS SURVEY SUBDIVIDED SECTION 28.

A CLOSED TRAVERSE WAS RUN AROUND THIS PARCEL, USING A SOKKIA SET IIIB. A 5" TOTAL STATION. THE FIELD NOTE BOOK IS ON FILE IN THE FOREST SUPERVISOR'S OFFICE, BAKER CITY,

CORNER MONUMENTATION NOTES

MONUMENTS ESTABLISHED DURING THIS SURVEY ARE 3 1/4" DIAMETER ALUMINUM CAPS ON 30" LONG BY 3" DIAMETER ALUMINUM PIPES, WITH CAST FLANGED BASES. BELOW EACH MONUMENT ESTABLISHED, I PLACED A MAGNETIC MEMORIAL AND A BRASS WASHER. THE WASHER IS MARKED LS 2211 AND I STAMPED "AP" AND THE CORNER NUMBER OF THE MONUMENT, AS IN: AP 2, AP 3 & AP 4. I PLACED A COLLAR OF STONE AROUND THE PIPE. AT A DISTANCE OF 3 TO 5 FEET, FROM EACH MONUMENT, ON EACH PROPERTY LINE. I PLACED A STEEL POST WITH A PROPERTY BOUNDARY SIGN ATTACHED. IN ADDITION ON ONE POST AT EACH CORNER ! ATTACHED A LAND SURVEY MONUMENT SIGN. NO OTHER ACCESSORIES WERE ESTABLISHED.






