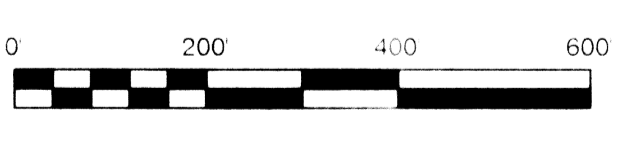

1974 County Surveyer 2 1/2" aluminum cap on 1 galv pipe. I do not believe this is the original corner position. Several ties made while surveying Warren Heights Addition indicate the corner should be 4 to 5 feet Southeast from the monument. And about 1979 I found a tree that was scribbled 1/4 X but I could not find any record as to what it represented. With the possible adjustment being relatively small and having more impact as previous surveys I decided to leave the corner alone.
