
- Found 5/8" iron rod with attached aluminum ODOT cap, see Highway Drawing No. 8B-35-6

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Rick Berry. The purpose of this survey was to survey and monument the corners shown for a property exchange between adjoining land owners.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing monuments and to establish the monuments shown hereon. Baker County Planning has approved this property line adjustment, PLA-10-002.

I accepted the monuments from Baker County Land Partition No. P2010-001, recorded in the office of the Baker County Clerk. I used the deed record calls to place the easterly line of deed Book 97-01-008. The location of the new property lines were approved by the landowners.
