#### History of original corner establishment:

Corner ESTABLISHED by Wm. W. Elmer, U.S. Deputy Mineral Surveyor, under instructions dated November 28, 1905, for the Survey of Orleans Millsite, MS 653 B.

Surveyor General records state:

Cor No 3 (Orleans Millsite), identical with SW Cor of the location, A pine post 4 ins by 6 ins 4 ft long set 1 1/2 ft in ground with a mound of earth and stone, scribed 3-653-B.Or.M

whence a pine 6 ins dia bears N86°42'W, 27.44 ft.

A pine 8 ins dia bears N58\*12'W, 34.40 ft, both blazed and scribed, 3-653-Or.M.BT.

Corner was remonumented by: William L. Hanley, per Corner Report 9-37-158; dated 2-18-88.

Found a 3"  $\times$  3"  $\times$  24" piece of decaying wood post in surrounding rock mound with no scribing & a 3"  $\times$  2.8' wood post laying beside rock mound and scribed Cor 3 O M on one face and Cor 2 A on the other face.

OBT: A dead lodgepole 8" dia brs N58\*12'W, 34.4' dist per record scribed 3 653 B M BT. A rotting lodgepole wind blow 6" dia brs N86\*42'W, 27.4' dist as per record with no scribing.

At position of wood post with surrounding rock mound ...

Removed wood post and replaced with 2"  $\times$  30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap 25" in ground, surrounded with mound of earth & stone, cap marked as shown in corner digram. Set 6' steel fence post alongside with signs 54-2 & 54-9 attached. Laid wood post alongside.

New bearing trees established:

A lodgepole pine 7" dia brs S35°E, 6.9' dist mkd OMS-3-653B BT. A lodgepole pine 6" dia brs N81°W, 8.7' dist mkd OMS-3-653B BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3~&~54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red paint around each BT.

Compass declination 20° East.

A steel T-post bears N37°W, 10 feet; with sign: Property Boundary


