SURVEY NARRATIVE:

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED DURING DEC., 1994 AND JAN., 1995 AT THE REQUEST OF THE USDA-FOREST SERVICE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFINING AND MONUMENTING A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR ACQUISITION BY THE FOREST SERVICE. THE SURVEY WAS PERFORMED BY GARY LANGLITZ, LS1099, DAVID CHRISS, LS2636, AND PETER ELDER, LSIT, USING A WILD TIGIOYDII600 ONE SECOND TOTAL STATION. AN OPEN-ENDED, NON-ADJUSTED TRAVERSE WAS PERFORMED, WHICH INCLUDED TIES TO THE EXISTING MONUMENTS FROM BAKER COUNTY SURVEY NO. 9-39-200 AND AN OBSERVATION OF AN INTERMEDIATE POINT BETWEEN EACH TRAVERSE POINT FOR DETECTION OF BLUNDERS. THE LOCATION OF THE MONUMENTS SHOWN FROM SURVEY 9-39-200 WERE FOUND TO CONFORM TO THE RECORD AND THE DIMENSIONS SHOWN ON THIS RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP ARE IDENTICAL TO THE DIMENSIONS OF SURVEY 9-39-200.


