

PARTITION PLAT NO. 1997- 000 SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, James D. Hanley, certify that I have correctly surveyed and prepared this partition plat in accordance with O.R.S. Chapter 92 by direction of the owners. This partition is described as follows:

In the SWI/4 NWI/4 of Section 4, T. 9 S., R. 39 E., W.M.:

Beginning N. 81° 12′ 00″ E., 251.84 feet from the West quarter corner of said Section to a found City of Baker established 3/4 inch pipe monument; thence S. 88° 53′ 52″ E., 651.96 feet to a found City of Baker 3/4 inch pipe monument marking the Southeast corner of this subject property; thence N. 0° 25′ 07″ W., 1239.51 feet to intersect the South right of way line of the Baker County Pine Creek Road; thence N. 89° 56' 20" W., 651.75 feet along the said road; thence S. O' 25' 07" E., 1227.67 feet to the point of beginning.

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Renews June 30, 1997

The purpose of this survey and plat is to legally document the division of land into two parcels and mark the corners on the ground with proper monumentation. This land was previously owned by City of Baker, and broken into 6 tracts by City of Baker. This subject part of that division was previously described as Tracts No, 3, 4 and 5. The city did not subdivide Section 4 for the correct boundaries of the SWI/4 NWI/4, but did establish monumentation displaying intent. The South and East lines of this partition are controlled by the found pipes set

This land, consisting of Tracts No. 3, 4 and 5, was equally divided into two pieces without authority. Lines are adjusted to provide 60 feet wide access to the Southerly portion and the boundary distances are based on this
