

## **NARRATIVE**

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED FOR THE WALLOWA-WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST, WITH THE PURPOSE OF MONUMENTING THE CORNERS OF THAT CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN DEED TO BAKER CITY, RECORDED FEBRUARY 27, 1901 IN DEED BOOK 39, PAGE 164. SAID TRACT IS SITUATED IN THE NW1/4 SECTION 32, T.9S., R.39E., W.M.

TO DETERMINE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY REQUIRED THE SUBDIVISION OF THE NW1/4 OF SAID SECTION 32. A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. IN 1971/1972, B.L.M. CADASTRAL SURVEYORS GERALD E. CHITTICK AND JOHN H. NELSON PERFORMED A DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTIONS OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY, SUBDIVISIONAL LINES AND MINERAL SURVEY NO. 763, T.9S., R.39E., W.M., UNDER GROUP NO. 751, APPROVED JULY 9, 1971. IN 1986, JAMES HANLEY, PLS, PERFORMED THE MARBLE CADASTRAL SURVEY FOR THE U.S. FOREST SERVICE UNDER CONTRACT NO. 53-04HI-9638 N, RECORDED AS BAKER COUNTY SURVEY NO. 9-39-200. MR. HANLEY ALSO PREPARED CORNER MONUMENTATION RECORDS FOR THE CORNERS ASSOCIATED WITH SURVEY NO. 9-39-200. THESE WERE FILED SEPARATELY AS SURVEY NO.'S 9-39-144, 9-39-145, 9-39-146, 9-39-158, 9-39-159 AND 9-39-160.

FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO RECOVER APPURTENANT CONTROLLING MONUMENTS FROM THE AFOREMENTIONED SURVEYS, WHICH WERE ALL FOUND IN PLACE AND ACCEPTED. THE NW1/4 WAS THEN SUBDIVIDED TO DETERMINE THE LOCATIONS OF THE ALIQUOT PART LINES AND THE CENTER-NORTH 1/16 CORNER, ALL OF WHICH CONTROL THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SUBJECT TRACT. NEW MONUMENTS WERE SET ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND AND THE DEED RECORD, AS SHOWN HEREON.

SEE THE CORNER MONUMENTATION RECORD FILED SEPARATELY FOR MORE DETAILS REGARDING THE MONUMENT SET AT THE CENTER-NORTH 1/16 CORNER, AND ITS ACCESSORIES.

THE PROPERTY LINES WERE MARKED WITH NEW ALUMINUM POSTS WITH NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY SIGNS ATTACHED.


