

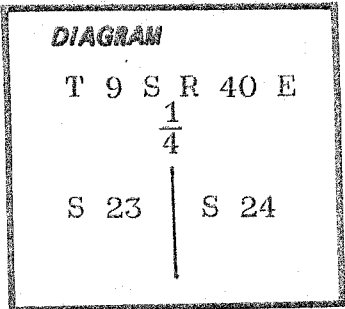
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Thompson and Chaplin under GLO contract no. 104 dated April 16, 1864.

Surveyor General records state:

Set stone 18 x 10 x 6 ins. for 1/4 sec cor.



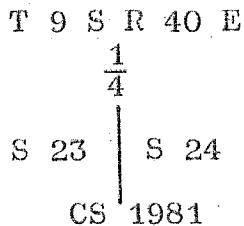
Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 17 x 12 x 6 ins marked 1/4.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2 inch brass cap on a 1 inch iron pipe 31 inches long and projecting 6 inches out of the ground. Buried original stone on north side of new monument.

Brass cap marked thus:
