


SURVEY NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Roger Abbas and Baker Valley Rendering Company for the purpose of monumenting the property boundary of that parcel of land described in Baker County Deeds, Book 169 at Page 1043; and in Baker County Deeds film volume 72-50-008, and located in the NE4NW4 Section 14, T 9 S, R 40 E, W.M. Accurate boundary establishment was required for construction of a new fence around the property.

Survey control was recovered from a previous survey, filed under Baker County Survey No. 9-40-54, from which said Section 14 was partially subdivided. The ditch referred to in the above noted deed instruments was located from somewhat obliterated remains of ditch excavation. As shown on this map, the deed record distances from the Northwest corner of the NE4NW4 to the ditch and the deed record distance between ditch crossings along the North line NE4NW4 vary from the measurements of this survey. It appears that the North line NE4NW4 was not definitely determined at the time of the above noted deed preparation.
