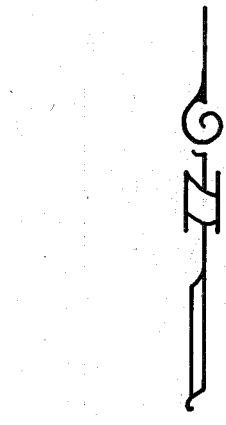

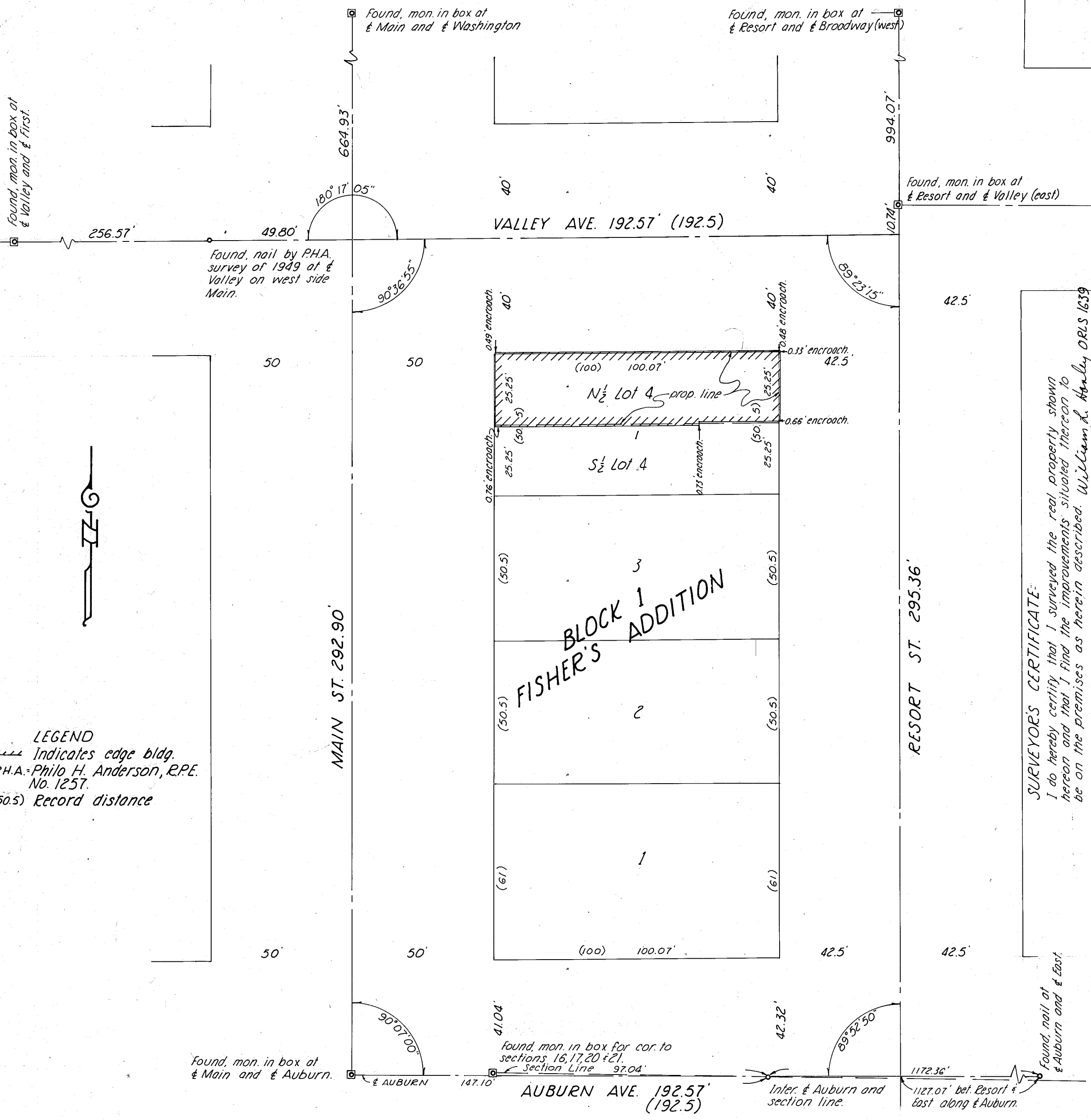

NARRATIVE TO ACCOMPANY SURVEY

There is no monumentation on Valley & Main, Valley & Resort, and Resort & Auburn.
Valley & Main St. intersection recovered by extending the line between the found P.H.A. nail and
First & Valley monument East to the centerline of Main St. between found monuments on Auburn
and Washington Sts.
Valley & Resort (for Valley between Main & Resort) from data on P.H.A. STANDARD OIL CO. MAP survey
of 1932, print of which is in City Engr. Files. P.H.A. states street intersection is 1.31 feet South of
manhole on centerline of Resort St. This manhole is 9.43 feet South of monument for Valley run-
ning East by measurement this survey.
The original plat of FISHER'S ADDITION gives no distance for Auburn St. width. I have there-
fore used plat distances for lot widths.
