



NARRATIVE

By traversing between the found Northeast corner, the East quarter corner and the South quarter corners of Sec. 16: Reestablished the Southeast section corner of Sec. 16 (also being the Northeast corner of Section 20) from the CITY SURVEY OF 1970 map data. Highway I-80 construction has obliterated the fence corner marking the original section corner location. Set a 5/8-inch x 30 inch rebar on the basis of the above section subdivisional data for the Northwest corner of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 21.

The found monuments of an unrecorded survey for Tom Rudolph do not conform to the section subdivisional data and their significance is not known. See Legend.
