**SURVEY NARRATIVE**

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF FRANK GRAY, LANDOWNER, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARTITIONING TWO PARCELS FROM THAT LAND IN BLOCK 54 AND VACATED "G" STREET, B. W. LEVEN'S SECOND ADDITION, UNDER HIS OWNERSHIP. THE BASIS OF THIS SURVEY IS BAKER COUNTY SURVEY NO. 9-40-184 FILED MAY 28, 1982, WHICH SHOWS PROPER REESTABLISHMENT OF THE BOUNDARIES OF BLOCK 54 AND THE BOUNDARIES OF THAT LAND REVERTED BACK TO PRIVATE OWNERSHIP THROUGH VACATION OF "G" STREET AND THE ALLEY THROUGH BLOCK 54. (VACATION ORDINANCE NO. 2222) PROPER PROFESSIONAL AND STATUTORY METHODS WERE USED TO PERFORM THIS SURVEY.
